Sanction & rules : Ski Québec Alpin sanction. SQA rules will apply.

Eligibility :

- Competitors must be 18 years or older on December 31, 2018.
- Every participant must have a Master's National card or a FIS Master's card.
- SQA Master's event card will be available for online purchasing at a cost of 135\$ when you register for the event. The Master's event card can also be bought directly from SQA **before** you register via online registration on the platform.
- American racers must prove that they have a **valid** USSA or FIS Master's card number and **must not** buy the SQA weekend card.
- Please indicate your card valid number on the registration platform in the box for this purpose.
- Registration is limited to the first 80 participants with a maximum quota of 20 American racers.

Athletes banquet : On Saturday March 2 at 19:00 at the principal ski lodge, located at Stoneham Mountain Resort. Extra tickets will be available for guests at a cost of 65\$/ticket (all taxes and service included, limited quantities). A vegetarian meal option will be available, please specify it while registering online. **No extra tickets will be available at the door. All tickets must be purchased in advance via online registration on the platform.**

Bibs : One single bib will be given to all competitors to keep as a souvenir but must be worn for all the championship events. Bibs will be given at the registration desk upon your arrival.

Protests : Every protest must be written in accordance with the FIS ruling and be accompanied by a 100\$ cash deposit. (RIS 644.4).

Racers meeting : Racers meeting will be held on second floor in the Stoneham Ski Club chalet, at the base of slope #2 on Wednesday February 27 at 18h00. A bib draw by age group will be done for the championships. You will keep your bib for the entire championships.

Result board : Bottom of slope #2, near the finish area, and on livetiming.com.

Awards : Saturday March 2 for the GS and SG events, during the banquet.
Sunday March 3 for the SL event and the championships overall awards, 60 minutes after the course removal, at the bottom of slope #2, near the Ski Club's chalet.

Overall awards will be presented in each age group, based on the result of all 4 races (you must finish all 4 races to qualify for the overall). Overall results will be calculated as a combined time of all 4 races.
