	<b>CANADIAN MASTERS ALPINE CHAMPIONSHIPS (CMAC)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Competitors must be 18 years or older on 31 December, 2022.</li> <li>Canadian participants must have a valid (ACTIVE) racer card: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Masters FIS code</li> <li>- Canadian Master's card or an event card.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>Out- of-province Masters weekend cards will not be accepted. BC Alpine Masters Event Card will be available for purchase on Zone 4 when registering. <b>ENTRY DEADLINE:</b>	1900 hrs, Wednesday, 01 February 2023: As per FIS Master ICR MA 6), all entries must be final and complete no later than 24 hours before first draw at Team Captains. Withdrawals must be made prior to the first draw. There are no refunds after first draw.
