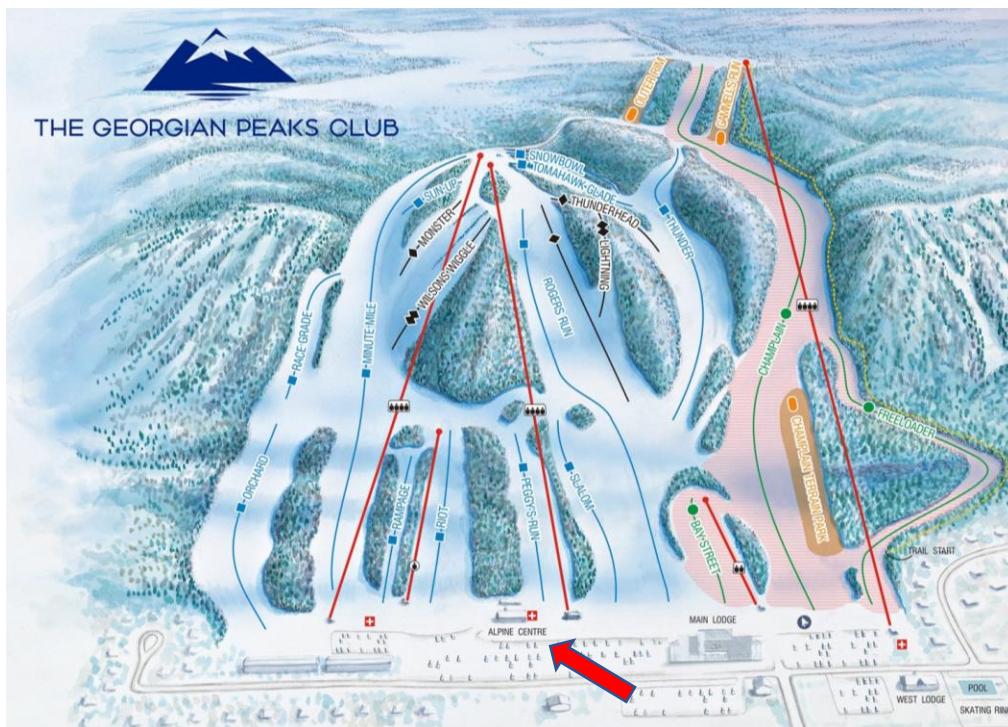

LOCATION:	The Georgian Peaks Club - MINUTE MILE to ORCHARD
ENTRY:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Race fee = \$400 per Team, plus \$45 lift ticket per racer for non-Georgian Peaks members. Exchange tickets are not permitted.• Team = four (4) racers 18 years or older on 31-Dec-22 with minimum of one female per Team.• Individual entries (\$100 + \$45 lift ticket) will be placed on a Team.

DEADLINE:	All registrations and payment info must be received by 28 February 2023; event is confirmed with 100+ entries.
WAIVERS:	All race participants must sign the Georgian Peaks Special Events Waiver when they collect their bib and lift ticket.
OTHER:	Registered racers will be awarded Masters' World Cup Points that will be provided separately after the event by Alpine Canada Masters.

Thank you in advance!• The course will be closed after inspection and any movement on the hill will result in disqualification without refund; this will be strictly enforced.
