EVENT:	2023 Ontario Masters' Championships GS & SL Saturday 11 March 2023
LOCATION:	The Georgian Peaks Club
RACE HILL:	Race Grade
ENTRY:	\$80 for 2 races or \$65 for 1 race (plus appropriate accreditation) + \$45 lift ticket for non-Georgian Peaks members. Exchange tickets are not permitted. No entries without an active Master's Competitor Card.
SANCTION:	Alpine Ontario Alpine (AOA)
ELIGIBILITY:	Competitors must be 18 years or older on 31 December 2022. All racers must hold a current Master's National or FIS or Weekend Event competitor card; competitors must be registered on https://www.alpinepoints.ca/racerProfile/ except for US competitors. AOA competitor cards can be purchased at https://snowreg.com/#!/listings/alpine-ontario/CL-AOA Note: A FIS RH2013 compliant helmet is required for the GS race & no soft-eared helmets are permitted for the SL.
REGISTRATION:	Registration is online at: Ontario Masters Championships Registration
DEADLINE:	All registrations and payment info must be received by 28 February 2023; must have a minimum of 60 entries by 28-Feb-23 to proceed with event.
AGE CATEGORIES:	18-29; 30-34; 35-39; 40-44; 45-49; 50-54; 55-59; 60-64; 65-69; 70-74; 75-79; 80-84; 85-89; 90+
AWARDS:	Awards will be presented on the deck of the Main Lodge approximately ¾ hour after the last slalom race. AOA medals awarded for overall combined, by age category. Champion of Champions trophy awarded to first female and first male overall. Canadian Masters' World Cup Points awarded for combined times of GS and SL races.
PROTESTS:	\$50 cash non-refundable – to be submitted according to FIS rules.

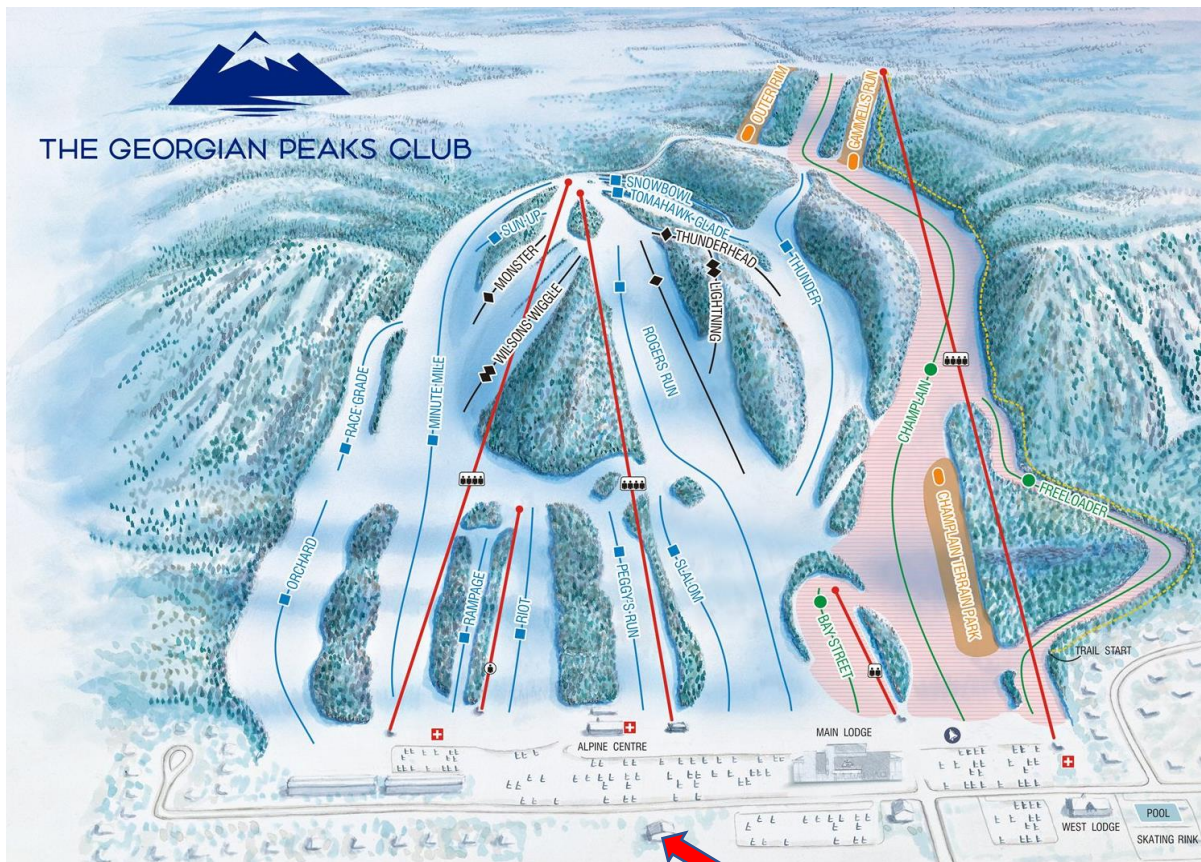
