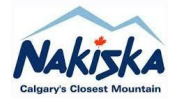

<b>Sanction:</b>	Alberta Alpine & Alpine Canada Alpin
<b>Eligibility:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Master competitors must be 18 years or older on 31 December 2024.</li> <li>• All Master racers must hold a current Alberta Masters Weekend Card, ACA Master's National (MS or NC) or ACA Master's M1 competitor card or FIS Master's competitor card (international 30+ racers) or USSA Masters' competitor card (USA 18-29 racers). Can be purchased via <a href="#">RAMP</a></li> <li>• Canadian U16 and U14 must hold a current ACA national card.</li> </ul>
<b>Age Categories:</b>	18-29; 30-34; 35-39; 40-44; 45-49; 50-54; 55-59; 60-64; 65-69; 70-74; 75-79; 80-84; 85-89; 90+ and U16 & U14
<b>Bibs:</b>	A single bib will be assigned to each participant & must be worn for the entire event. Pickup bibs from the Race Office; after your last race, return the bib to the Race Office or leave at the finish line. If you fail to return your bib, you will be charged \$50.
<b>Protests:</b>	CAD160 cash (CHF100) non-refundable - to be submitted according to FIS rules.
<b>Equipment Notes:</b>	A FIS RH2013 compliant helmet is required for the SG & GS races; a soft-eared helmet may be permitted for the SL. Back protection is also required.
<b>Awards:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• SG and GS awards at banquet. SL and Overall Awards will be presented after the tear down of the race on Sunday, 9-Mar-25, outside of the Race Office.</li> <li>• CMAC medals awarded for overall combined, by 5-year age category and gender.</li> <li>• CMAC medals for each of the four events (SG1, SG2, GS, SL) may be awarded by 5-year age category &amp; gender. However, dependent on participation numbers at registration close, the medal awards may be presented in 10-year age categories and/or other grouping that will be communicated to participants, by the National Committee and ROC, before the first race.</li> <li>• Champion of Championship trophy awarded to first female and first male overall using Canadian Masters World Cup points</li> <li>• Dave Murray Cup awarded to the top region or province, only if a fair balance of participants across regions or provinces at registration close; the National Committee will advise the ROC and participants if not awarded for that year.</li> <li>• U16 &amp; U14 awards are per ROC.</li> </ul> <p>Note: Races will not have National Points results for U16 or U14 athletes.</p>
<b>World Cup Points:</b>	Canadian Masters' World Cup Points awarded in 5-year age categories for each of the four events: SG1, SG2, combined times of GS & combined times of SL races.
<b>Entry Deadline:</b>	4pm, February 27, 2025. Late entries will be charged a \$20/race late fee. Registration closed after 4pm March 3, 2025
