Bibs:	A single bib will be assigned to each participant & must be worn for the entire event.

SL awards at the banquet and approximately 45 minutes after the GS. ECMAC medals for each of the three individual races (SL1, SL2 & GS combined) may be awarded by 5-year age category & gender for non-FIS athletes; the 18-29 age category will be awarded medals for the three individual races. ECMAC medals awarded for overall combined of the three events (SL1, SL2 & GS combined), by 5-year age category and gender. 		
World Cup Points:	Canadian Masters' World Cup Points awarded in 5-year age categories for each of the three events: SL1, SL2 and GS combined.
