## Deadline Extended for 2024 ON Masters' Championships

The registration deadline has been extended to Wednesday, 13 March 2024, for the Ontario Masters Championships, being held at [Devil's Glen Country Club](#), on Saturday, 16 March 2024. The event is a 2-run giant slalom race followed by a 2-run slalom race – see the [race notice](#) for more details.

The cost is \$100 for the two disciplines or \$75 for one discipline, including lift ticket.

A minimum of 50 is required for the event to proceed. AOA will refund the registration cost if the event is cancelled, however, the AOA weekend card is non-refundable so hold off purchasing same until the event is confirmed.

## 2024 Ontario Masters' Championships

The [race notice](#) is out for the 2024 Ontario Masters' Championships being held on Saturday, 16 March 2024, at [Devil's Glen Country Club](#). The event is a 2-run giant slalom race followed by a 2-run slalom race. AOA medals will be awarded for overall combined, by age categories. The Champion of Champions trophy is awarded to first female and first male overall, on a handicap basis. Bib draws will be held at the awards ceremony following the races.

All racers must hold a current Masters' National or FIS or Weekend-Event competitor card as this is an AOA sanctioned event; competitors must be registered on [AlpinePoints.ca](#) except for US competitors; out of province racers must register through their PSO. AOA competitor cards can be purchased through [SnowReg](#).

The cost is \$100 for the two disciplines or \$75 for one discipline, including lift ticket.

The registration deadline is Friday, 8 March 2024, at 5 pm, with a MINIMUM of 50 entries to proceed with the event.

## 2024 FIS Master's Licence | Published 05/12/2023 20:01

The upcoming ski season is rife with the following FIS Masters races that may interest you to participate in:

- 2024 [World Winter Masters Games](#) (WWMG) being held from 11-21 January 2024, in the Lombardy region of Italy, with [alpine racing](#) at Aprica and Ponte di Legno, from 16-19 January 2024.
- 2024 [FIS Masters Cup](#) (FMC) being held from 23-25 February 2024, in Beaver Creek CO.
- 2024 [FIS World Criterium Masters Alpine Skiing](#) (WCM) being held from 1-7 March 2024, in Kimberley BC; first time the Criterium ever held in Canada!
- 2024 [FIS Masters Race](#) (MAS) & [Canadian Masters Alpine Championships](#) (CMAC) being held from 9-11 March 2024, in Nakiska AB.

### **Licence Requirements:**

Now is the time to think about getting your FIS Master's licence for 30+ racers, as at 31 December; how you obtain this varies from province to province, so if you need help, contact your local club or coach or your [Masters' Provincial Representative](#).

A FIS Master's licence is needed for at least three of the four events listed above, except for CMAC but more on that below.

For those competing at WWMG\*, I strongly recommend you obtain/renew your 2024 FIS Master's licence asap so that your name is on the last published FIS points list prior to your first FMC race. If your FIS Master's licence is not active before the first FIS race you intend entering, you will not be permitted to race. If your licence is active ahead of that race, but not in time to be on the last published FIS points list, your start will be with other 999 point holders, even if you have lower points.

\* You may have read something in the WWMG Alpine Guide about racers without a FIS licence starting in the respective age group after the FIS Masters racers. Rich Deacon, Canadian Master & organizer of "Canada House", reached out to the WWMG Alpine Competition Manager, to find out this is incorrect, and the guide is being updated!

\* For anyone having trouble registering for WWMG on the ENDU site, feel free to reach out to [Lewis Heilig](#), the past QC rep, as he has taken the time to document the myriad of steps to do so on that platform, however, we recommend you [verify](#) your registration beforehand.

In any case, if you intend on racing at either the FIS Masters Cup (FMC), in Beaver Creek CO, or the FIS World Criterium Masters (WCM), in Kimberley BC, you will need your FIS Master's licence, so don't delay!

For more information on the ins and outs of FIS Masters, ranking, and much more, see the [article](#) prepared by Mike Robbins.

If you've ever held a FIS Master's licence then lookup your [biography](#), plus make sure your year of birth is correct! There is also a FIS mobile app, which does not behave quite the same way, but contains most of the same information.

Of the four events listed above, the only race that you do not need a FIS Master's licence is for CMAC. At minimum, you will need either an Alpine Canada Master's competitor card or a weekend card; the latter can be purchased when registering. Please note that the CMAC races are also FIS "MAS" category races (MAS being similar to FMC races except that any points awarded do not count towards a crystal globe so if you read Mike Robbin's article above, you will know what this means!).

If you are still confused, reach out to your [Provincial Masters Representative](#) or [Contact Us](#).

### **WCM, FMC & MAS Pre-Race Entry Forms:**

Well ahead of each WCM or FMC or MAS race, you must advise your Coach or the Race Administrator of your home club which FIS races you will be entering, asking that they prepare the required [FIS Entry Form](#) on your behalf and submit it to your Provincial Sports Organization (PSO). Your PSO will consolidate all forms received from other clubs/racers, attending the same event, and forward on to Alpine Canada (ACA) who then consolidates all provinces before forwarding to FIS. This is how your name ends up on the race start list for any given event; a cumbersome procedure at best, but it is what it is, so get this done well ahead of each event!

Note to Ontario Masters: Alpine Ontario (AOA) advised there is no need for your home club to send in the FIS Entry Form on your behalf and that you are to send an email directly to Suki Chapman on [memberservices@alpineontario.ca](mailto:memberservices@alpineontario.ca) with the following information, for each FIS event you are attending:

- Competition Name & Place e.g. WWMG, Italy
- Date of race e.g. 16-19 January 2024
- FIS Code e.g. 5nnnnnn
- Last Name, First Name
- Year of Birth (YYYY)
- Race Entries e.g. DH, SG, GS, SL, AC
- Arrival Date (DD.MM.YY) & Departure Date (DD.MM.YY)

## QC Deadlines to Purchase 2023/24 Cards

The ski season is rapidly approaching and there are some big events on the horizon such as the World Winter Masters Games (WWMG), in Italy, and the FIS World Criterium Masters (WCM), at Kimberley BC. For those who are thinking of participating in the latter, note that this event will not be combined with the Canadian Masters Alpine Championships (CMAC) that are being held the following week, at Nakiska AB, so that means that a FIS card is necessary for 30+ racers. The ACA National Card is required for certain other races across Canada where single-event cards are not being offered as well as for racers in the 18-29 age category. We strongly recommend that QC 30+ Masters register for the FIS Master's Card that includes the ACA National card.

Cards take time to be activated so don't leave registration to the last minute as your name must appear on the most recent FIS points list before the entry deadline of any races you wish to enter; we recommend you purchase your card by 1 December 2023. Plus, there are additional fees for "Immediate FIS List Activation" – list release dates can be found by clicking on [this link](#).

SQA registration goes through one of their member clubs; if you are not a member of a Masters' Race Team i.e. a Master who trains with a ski-school program or independently, then you will need to make arrangements with a local club to approve your race registration and to submit the "FIS Entry Form" on your behalf. For a FIS Master's registration, it is also necessary to have sufficient accident insurance corresponding to the [SAIP insurance](#), of the appropriate class as offered by ACA, or the equivalent private coverage if you already have it.

On the [SQA member login page](#) use the link "My Documents" to upload the completed forms and add them to your profile; all forms are available to download from the SQA [Athlete Area](#) page :

- FIS Athlete Declaration
- SQA Insurance Waiver
- ACA Medical Evaluation – note this form is not mandatory for Masters' athletes.

Following that, use the link "Join and Pay" to submit the request by choosing the club you are affiliated with and the category "FIS Master"; once the request has been approved (which may take a few days) you can return to the site and check your registration status at which time you can finalize the payment to complete the registration.

This winter also brings another [WWMG](#) in January 2024, in Lombardy, Italy. Watch for announcements and updates on the program as well as accommodations arranged, once again, by Rich Deacon at [deacon@sobek.ca](mailto:deacon@sobek.ca). The WWMG is always well attended by Canadian Masters.

## **FIS World Criterium Masters Alpine Skiing (WCM)**

It's official!! We are hosting the 2024 FIS World Criterium Masters, in Kimberley BC; mark your calendar for 1-7 March with unofficial SG training on 28-29 February.

The program will include official SG training on 1-Mar-24 with 1x SG, 1x GS and 1x SL for the Criterium, plus an additional FMC GS race. Each men's A, men's B and women's C groups will have four days of racing and two days off during the event. The program details are yet to be ironed out but as soon as they are available, they will be posted and distributed.

For those not familiar with Kimberley, you can fly into Calgary airport and drive four hours to Kimberley for the Criterium and then three and a half hours back to Nakiska for Rides of March and finally one hour back to Calgary airport; or you can fly into the Rockies International Airport in Cranbrook which is a 20 minute drive from the Resort.

There are two main hotels at the base of the hill to choose from being [Trickle Creek Lodge](#) and [Mountain Spirit Resort](#), however, details on accommodation packages for the Criterium will follow with the event program.

The USA will be hosting their FMC races at Beaver Creek from 23-25 February 2024 and Nakiska is scheduled to host their Rides of March the following weekend 8-10 March 2024. Lots of racing for everyone and will certainly provide value for everyone to attend.
